

Crocheted Duduza Doll

Use scraps of chunky/bulky yarn and a J hook. Or use scraps of worsted weight yarn and a I hook. Use brown or black for the face and feet – and lots of bright colors for the rest. It's fun to use a fuzzy (black or dark brown) yarn for the hair!

Chain Row: With yarn for feet (black or brown), chain (ch) 27

Row 1: Single Crochet (SC) in 2nd chain from hook and each chain across, ch 1, turn.
(You will have 26 SC in each row until we start to decrease.)

Rows 2 & 3: SC in each SC, ch 1, turn.

Row 4: Change to skirt or pants color. SC in each SC, ch 1 turn. Place a clip on marker on the side you choose as "Right Side" somewhere on the "skirt or pants". This is just to keep it straight if you want to do anything fancy on the right side.

Rows 5 – 14: SC in each SC, ch 1, turn. (10 rows)

Rows 15 & 16: Change to belt color and continue in SC pattern.

Rows 17 – 23: Change to shirt/blouse color and continue in SC pattern. (7 rows)

Row 24: 1st decrease row – decrease 3 stitches evenly across row in this manner: *SC in first 5 SC, SC DECREASE in next 2 stitches* repeat twice from * to*, SC 5, ch 1 turn.

Row 25: Change to face color (brown or black), SC in each stitch, ch 1 turn (23 SC)

Row 26 & 27: SC in each SC, ch 1, turn.

Row 28: 2nd decrease row – decrease 2 stitches evenly across row in this manner: *SC in

First 6 SC, SC DECREASE in next 2 stitches* repeat once from * to *, SC 7, ch 1, turn.
(21 SC)

Row 29 - 31: SC in each SC, ch1, turn. (3 rows)

Row 32: Change to sweatband color, SC in each SC, ch1, turn.

Row 33: SC in each SC, ch 1, turn.

Row 34: Change to hair or cap color, SC in first 2 SC, SC decrease in next 2 stitches, and across, SC in last 3 SC, ch 1, turn.

Row 35: SC in each stitch across, ch 1, turn.

Row 36: SC in first SC, SC decrease in next 2 stitches and across, SC in last SC, ch1, turn.

Row 37: SC in each stitch across, fasten off.

Please follow the finishing directions for the knit version! Embroider the faces as you choose!
