

## Cot Size Ripple Blanket - Crochet

**3st dec:** - 3 stitch decrease (dec 3 tog) \*yarn over (yo), insert hook through next stitch, yo and pull loop through stitch, yo and pull through first 2 loops on hook; repeat from \* twice. yo and pull through remaining 4 loops on hook.

**2st dec:** - 2 stitch decrease (dec 2 tog) \*yo, insert hook through next stitch, yo and pull loop through stitch, yo and pull through first 2 loops on hook; repeat from \* once, yo and pull through remaining 3 loops on hook.

Calls for about 25oz of worsted weight yarn. Use single strand of yarn and K hook for nice weight fabric.

Chunky or two strands of worsted? N hook and a chain of 66 works well

Pattern repeat: Multiple of 16 plus 2stitches



To begin 32" (36") wide ripple blanket: For K hook: Chain 98 (114). For L hook: Chain 82 (98)

**Row 1:** Dc in 3rd ch from hook, dc in next 6 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 6 ch, \*work 3 st dc in next 3 ch, dc in next 6 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 6 ch, repeat from \* across. End by working 2 st dec in last 2 ch. Ch 2 and turn

**Row 2:** Skip first stitch, dc in next 7 ch, 3 dc in next dc, (these 3 should be in middle dc of 3 dc set on previous row), dc in next 6 dc, \*work 3 st dec in next 3 stitches, dc in next 6 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next d6, Repeat from \* across. End by working 2 st dec in last 2 dc. Ch 2 and t u r n .

Repeat row 2 until blanket measures approximately 72 inches long.

## Cot Size Knitted Blanket (approx.. 36" X 72")

### Materials:

Approximately 1800 yards total of a soft worsted weight (#4) yarn. You will be working with two strands of yarn held together while working this blanket.

Size US #13 29" or longer circular needle

### Gauge:

Approximately 12 stitches/16 rows = 4" with two strands of worsted weight (#4) held together.

### Abbreviations:

k knit  
p purl  
st(s) stitch(es)  
rep repeat

### Pattern:

Holding two strands of yarn together, cast on 116 stitches

Rows 1-5 knit

Row 6 (WS) (and all even rows from here on): k3, p to last 3 sts, k3

Row 7:(RS) (and all odd rows from here on): k

Rep rows 6 and 7 until blanket is about 71" long, then knit 5 rows and bind off all sts.
