Dippy Do Da Hat

Martha Wood

Using size 7 circular needles and worsted (4) yarn, cast on 66 sts & join. Place marker. Knit 8 rows.

Switch to size 8 needles and continue in pattern as follows:

Pattern:

Row 1: K5 *yo K1 yo K10, repeat 4 more times, yo K1 yo K5. (78 sts)

Rows 2, 4, 6, 8: Knit

Row 3: K5 *yo K3 yo K10, repeat 4 more times, yo K3 yo K5. (90 sts)

Row 5: K5 *yo K5 yo K10, repeat 4 more times, yo K5 yo K5. (102 sts)



Row 7: P2 tog 3 times, *K5, P2 tog 6 times* repeat 4 more times, K5, P2 tog 3 times. (66 sts) These 8 rows form pattern. - Repeat pattern 3 more times.

Decrease for crown: - change to DP needles size 8 when necessary

Row 1: K 5, K2tog (K2 together), K9, K2tog to last 4 stitches from original marker, place marker – this is new beginning of round

Row 2: Knit from marker you just placed around the row removing original marker when you reach it – continue K until you get to the marker which marks new beginning of round

Row 3: K8, K2tog around

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: K7, K2tog around

Follow decrease pattern until K4, K2tog around, Knit next row

Row 13:K3, K2 tog around

Row 14: K2 K2 tog around

Row 15 : K1, K 2tog around (12 sts)

Row 16:K 2 tog around – 6 stitches

Using a darning needle, draw yarn purlwise through stitches and secure tightly
