

# Lacy Chemo Hat

*A Lois Moore Creation*

1 Ball Cotton Yarn  
16" size 8 circular needle

Pattern Stitch:

Lace is done in multiples of 6 stitches , with an 8 row repeat

To begin, cast on 72 stitches. Join being careful not to twist stitches.

Knit every round for 10 rows for rolled brim, or choose another edging.

Begin lace pattern as follows:

Row 1 and all uneven numbered rows...knit

Row 2: \*yo, ssk, k1, k2 tog, yo, k1: repeat from \* around

Row 4: \* yo, k1,sl 1,k2 tog, pssso, k1, yo, k1: repeat from \* around

Row 6: \*k2 tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1: Repeat from \* around

Row 8: \* (k1,yo) twice, k1, sl 1, k2 tog, pssso: Repeat from \* to last 5 stitches, (k1, yo) twice, k1 ssk.

Repeat these 8 rows 3 or 4 times, depending on desired length needed.

Knit one row and begin decreases. I divided my 72 stitches into 6 sections of 12 stitches. I decreased by using ssk. I knitted rows between decrease rows until 4 decrease row were completed then began decreasing every row until 6 stitches remained. At this point cut yarn and thread thru remaining stitches.
