

# Lampshade Stitch Chemo Hat

*A Lois Moore Creation*

The sample was knitted on size 9, 16" circular needle  
Stitch pattern worked over multiples of 4  
Worsted Weight Yarn, 1 main color (MC), 1 contrast color (CC).

With MC, cast on 72 stitches. Join, being careful not to twist stitches.

Work 6 rows of knit 1, purl 1 ribbing or edging of your choice.

Knit 2 rows.

Pattern rows: Row 1: (CC)\* Knit 3, without dropping next st on left hand needle (LHN), put right hand needle (RHN) into st 2 rows below next st on LHN, draw through a loop, knit st on LHN, pass loop over st just made (1 DIP made)\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of row.

Row 2: Knit one round.

Row 3: (MC) Knit 1, \* make 1 DIP, knit 3\*, repeat to end of row.

Row 4: Knit one round.

Repeat pattern rows two or three times as on the sample or continue until hat measures approximately 7" from cast on edge.

Decrease rows: Row 1: knit 6, knit 2 together (k2tog). Repeat to end of row.

Row 2, 4, 6, 8: knit

Row 3: knit 5, k2tog. Repeat to end of row.

Row 5: knit 4, k2tog. Repeat to end of row.

Row 7: knit 3, k2tog. Repeat to end of row.

Row 9: knit 2, k2tog. Repeat to end of row.

Row 10: knit 1, k2tog. Repeat to end of row.

Row 11: knit 2 together. Repeat to end of row. 9 stitches remain.

Cut yarn and draw through these 9 stitches, pull snug and weave in ends.
