

# Quick and Easy Chemo Blanket

A Pam Greswolde Creation

**SIZE:** Approx. 30 inches x 48 inches

## **MATERIALS**

- 5 skeins super bulky weight yarn and a size P hook

**OR**

- 6 skeins bulky weight yarn and a size N hook

## **Using P hook and Super bulky yarn such as:**

- Red Heart Bright & Lofty
- Red Heart Light & Lofty
- Red Heart Baby Clouds
- Lion Brand Jiffy Thick & Quick
- Lion Brand Boucle
- Lion Brand Hometown

**Chain** 65. (will measure 48 inches)

### **Row 1:**

Sc and dc in 2nd ch from hook, \*skip 1 ch, sc and dc in next ch; rep from \* across. Ch 1, turn.

### **Row 2:**

Sc and dc in first dc, \*skip next sc, sc and dc in next dc; rep from \* across, skip last sc, chain 1 and turn. Repeat row 2 for pattern blanket measures 30 inches long, fasten off.



**Using N hook and Bulky yarn such as:**

- Red Heart Artesano
- Lion Brand Homespun

**OR**

- 2 strands of any medium weight yarn held together as you crochet

**Chain** 57. (Will measure 30 inches)

**Row 1:**

Sc and dc in 2nd ch from hook, \*skip 1 ch, sc and dc in next ch; rep from \* across. Ch 1, turn.

**Row 2:**

Sc and dc in first dc, \*skip next sc, sc and dc in next dc; rep from \* across, skip last sc, chain 1 and turn. Repeat row 2 for pattern blanket measures 30 inches long, fasten off.

If desired, complete a sc around the entire edge of the blanket with 3 sc in all corners. Fasten off and weave in ends.

The completed blanket below was made with 5 skeins of Bright & Lofty.
