Thanks everyone for answering our requests for jackets and sweaters for the Caroline County children, the hats and socks for our Kuwait military and blankets...blankets as well as squares for creating blankets for kids, adults, sick and the homeless...you have outdone yourselves! Did you know you have had a part in creating almost **180,000** items in our 12 years? Now that's a lot of yarn!

It's truly amazing how we can mention a need to you and KABAM! you are on it!! And in a big way! When the sweater/jacket call went out you answered it by creating over 150 of them. When we asked for hats, about 300 came in and socks...I lost count on them! Your ability to whip up items at just the mere mention of a need is astonishing.

Of course, with all those projects coming in, the yarn has fast been going out. Our cubbies have been emptier than I've ever seen them, and this is a good thing! It just shows how prolific we are, how much we care and enjoy helping others. Our incoming yarn donations as well as funds for purchasing yarn have been very slow. And I can

well understand that. With the economy the way it has been for so long now things like yarn are not just high on anyone's list of priorities. But...our friends at Coordinated Colors Yarn Shop in Yorktown and Gloucester have come through for us once again. They have donated about 500 skeins of beautiful, acrylic yarn for out use. We currently need baby items, blankets of all sizes, chemo hats and shrugs. As always, please make whatever you enjoy as we can use anything you make.


PLEASE LOCK DOORS (front and back) UPON LEAVING THE SHOP!
