

Angel Lace Baby Cap (2 needles)

This cap is worked from the top down.

The yarn and needles in the pattern will make a small child's-sized cap.

To make larger sizes, use thicker yarn and needles to suit.

Materials: DK or baby weight yarn.

Needles: US 5

Use one pair for the 2-needle cap.

Use a set of four double pointed for the seamless cap.

Abbreviations:

k – knit

k2tog - knit 2 together

make bobble - knit into front, back, and front again of next stitch
(3 sts from 1), turn and p3, turn and k3, slip first two sts over last knit st.

p – purl

pw - purlwise (move the stitches to the other needle without twisting them)

ssk - slip next two stitches separately to right needle, slip left needle into them from left to right and knit them together.

yb - take yarn to back of work

yf - bring yarn to front of work

yo - bring yarn to front and over needle to make a stitch

Two Needle Cap

Cast on 7 sts.

Row 1: K1, (yo, k1) 6 times - 13 sts

Rows 2, 4, 6, 8, 10: Purl

Row 3: K1, (yo, k1) 12 times - 25 sts

Row 5: K1, (yo, k2) 12 times - 37 sts

Row 7: K1, (yo, k3) 12 times - 49 sts

Row 9: K1, (yo, k4) 12 times - 61 sts

Row 11: K1, (yo, k5) 12 times - 73 sts

Row 12: Purl

Work lace eyelet stripe

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Knit

Row 3: K1, (yo, k2tog) to end

Row 4: Knit

Work 4 rows in stocking st (stockinette)

Work 14 rows of angel lace pattern stitch (two needle version). See below.

Work 2 rows in stocking st

Work 4 rows of lace eyelet stripe

Work 6 rows in stocking st while on last row ONLY, work a K2tog somewhere in the middle of the row to give you 72 sts.

Work k2, p2 rib for 19 rows or until required length

Cast off (bind off).

Add pom-pom if desired.



Detail of Angel Lace Pattern

Angel Lace pattern stitch

Multiple of 12 sts plus 1

Row 1: *K3, yf, slip 7 pw, yb, k2*, rep to last st, k1

Row 2: Purl

Rows 3 and 4: repeat rows 1 and 2

Row 5: *K6, make bobble, k5*, rep to last st, k1

Row 6: *P3, yb, slip 7 pw, yf, p2*, rep to last st, k1

Row 7: *K6, slip point of needle under the 3 long strands and knit the next st, k5*, rep to last st, k1

Row 8: Purl

Row 9: *K4, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k3*, rep to last st, k1

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: *K3, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k2*, rep to last st, k1

Row 12: Purl

Row 13: *K2, (K2tog, yo) twice, k1, (yo, ssk) twice, k1*, rep to last st, k1

Row 14: Purl
