

Basic Filet Shawl (Crochet)

Materials:

(US) size N hook

1 skein of Caron “Pounder” or sufficient Worsted Weight (#4) yarn in different colors to amount to ~16 oz.

Tapestry needle to weave in ends

Pattern:

ch 5, join with sl st in first ch to form beg loop.

Row 1: ch 4 (counts as beg ch 3 plus ch 1 now and throughout) dc in beg loop, (ch 1, dc) twice, turn.

Row 2: ch 4, dc in same st (i.e. space from which ch 4 started), (ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next dc) across to last dc, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in top of beg ch 3, turn.

Repeat row 2 until yarn runs out or add another skein for a larger shawl

Add a border if you wish

Fasten off, weave in ends and block if necessary.
