

Chevron Baby Blanket

Finished measurements:

Approx. 27.5" x 36"

Materials:

29" circular US 9 knitting needles.

160 yards in each of 5 different colors. Worsted weight (#4) cotton.

Choose colors which coordinate and then randomly assign a letter, A, B, C, D, E to each.

Gauge

16 sts in 4" / 10cm Stockinette stitch

Abbreviations:

k = knit

k2tog = knit two stitches together

md = mitered decrease (slip 2 sts tog as if to k2tog, k the next stitch, pass the 2 slipped sts over)

ssk = slip, slip, knit. Slip two stitches separately as if to knit, then place the left needle into the fronts of these two stitches and knit them together

yo = yarn over

Pattern:

With colour A cast on 121 stitches. **DO NOT JOIN** – circular needles are used for the sole purpose of accommodating the large number of stitches.

Row 1 (RS) and all right side rows:

k1, ssk, k9, yo, (k1, yo, k10, md, k10, yo) repeat brackets until 13 sts remain, k1, yo, k9, k2tog, k1

Row 2 (WS) and all wrong side rows:

Purl all stitches, purling yo's through the back loop

Repeat rows 1 and 2 working each colour for **10 rows** in the following manner:

Colour A, Colour B, Colour C, Colour D, Colour E,

Colour B, Colour C, Colour D, Colour E

Colour B, Colour C, Colour D, Colour E

Colour B, Colour C, Colour D, Colour A

Cast off loosely, sew in ends, and block
