

## Child's Basketweave Blanket

### Finished Measurements

Approx. 30" × 40"

### Materials:

2 different colors of soft worsted weight acrylic (#4) in coordinating pastels are used, held together, to make this quick-knit blanket.

You will need approximately 400 grams of **each** color (approx. 900 yards of **each** color). As two strands are held together throughout, it is important to pick a soft yarn and use a needle which creates a looser fabric.

Needle size: US 11

Yarn needle for darning in ends



Pattern detail

### Abbreviations:

k = knit

p = purl

sts = stitches

### Gauge:

10 sts and 17 rows = approx. 4" (i.e. the *width* of one 8 stitch square should be approx. 3 ¼ ")

### Instructions:

Holding one strand of each color together

Loosely cast on 72 sts

Knit 6 rows (garter stitch) then pattern as follows:

Rows 1 - 12            k4, (k8, p8) 4 times, k4.

Rows 13 – 26        k4, (p8, k8) 4 times, k4.

Repeat rows 1-26, six (6) times.

Knit 6 rows in garter stitch.

Bind off loosely.
