

Child's Crocheted Hat and Scarf Set

Materials:

Worsted Weight (#4) yarn, 90 yards for the hat, 250 yards for the scarf, = a total of 340 for both
Size I crochet hook (You can use a J hook for a slightly larger hat)

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Stitch marker

Finished size:

Scarf 5" wide X 50" long

Abbreviations:

ch chain
dc double crochet
rep repeat
sc single crochet
sl st slip stitch

Patterns:

Hat:

1. Chain 3 (counts as first dc throughout the pattern), then 12 dc in first chain (last from hook), sl st to join last dc to top of original ch 3 (13 dc total)
2. Chain 3 then 2 dc in each dc around, sl st in top of ch 3 to join (25 dc total)
3. Ch 3, *2dc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * around. Sl st in top of ch 3 to join (37 dc)
4. Ch 3, 1 dc in each dc around, sl st to join (37 dc)
5. Ch 3, 1dc, *2dc in next dc, 1 dc in next 2 dcs Rep from * around, sl st to join (50 dc)
6. Ch 3, 1 dc in each dc around. Sl st in top of ch 3 to join
7. Ch 3, 1 dc in each dc around. Sl st in top of ch 3 to join
8. Ch 3, 1 dc in each dc around. Sl st in top of ch 3 to join
9. Ch 3, 1 dc in each dc around. Sl st in top of ch 3 to join
10. Ch 3, 1 dc in each dc around. Sl st in top of ch 3 to join
11. Ch 1, sc in each dc around, sl st in ch 1 space (you might want to *place a marker* at the beg of this and the next few rounds to you will know where the new row begins)
12. Ch 1, sc in each dc around, sl st in ch 1 space
13. Ch 1, sc in each dc around, sl st in ch 1 space
14. Ch 1, sc in each dc around, sl st in ch 1 space
15. Ch 3, 1 dc in each sc space around (50 dc)
16. Ch 3, *2dc in next dc space, 1 dc in next two dc spaces. Rep from * around, sl st in top of ch 3 to join (68 dc)
17. Ch 3, *1 dc in next two dc, 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * around, join in top of ch 3 to join (91 dc)
18. Ch 1, sc into all dc's around and sl st in ch 1 to join (you may want to use the marker again to note beginning of row.)
19. Ch 1, sc in to all dc's around and end.
20. Weave in all ends



Scarf:

1. Chain 20
2. Dc in 3rd chain from hook (counts as first dc), dc in every chain space across, ch 3, turn (17 dc)
3. Dc in every dc space, chain 3, turn
4. Dc in every dc space, chain 3, turn
5. Dc in every dc space, chain 1,, turn
6. *Sc in every dc space across, ch 1, turn
7. Sc in every dc space across, ch 1, turn
8. Sc in every dc space across, ch 3, turn
9. Dc in every dc space, chain 3, turn
10. Dc in every dc space, chain 3, turn
11. Dc in every dc space, chain 3, turn
12. Dc in every dc space, chain 1,, turn



Rep the 7 –row pattern repeat (rows 6 – 12) until scarf is about 46” long ending on a row 12 and then

Next row (increases for ruffle):**

1. *2dc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * across, ending with a dc in top of the ch 3, chain 3, turn
2. *1 dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * across ending with a dc, chain 3, turn
3. *2dc in next dc, 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * across ending with 1 dc. End.

Return to beginning of scarf and pick up first chain space on RS of work, chain 3 in this space. Then work 3 rows of increases as given above at ** to match the ruffle on the other side.

Weave in all ends
