

Crochet V-Stitch Baby Blanket

Skill level: Easy

Size: One Size

28 × 30 in. (71 × 76 cm)

Materials:

- Approximately 500 yards EACH of two DK weight (#3) yarns in complimentary colors
- Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5
- Tapestry Needle for weaving in ends

Gauge:

4 V-sts + 5 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) with 1 strand of each yarn held together. **BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.



Abbreviations:

ch – chain
 dc – double crochet
 Rep – repeat
 sc – single crochet
 sk – skip
 sl st – slip stitch
 st(s) – stitch(es)

Stitch explanation:

V-Stitch Work (dc, ch 1, dc) in same stitch.

Blanket

With 1 strand each of each yarn held together, ch 88.

Row 1: (Dc, ch 1, dc) in 5th ch from hook, *sk 2 ch, work V-st in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk 1 ch, dc in last ch - 28 V-sts and dc at each end of row.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, work V-st in each ch -1 sp, end dc in top of turning chain.

Rows 3-34: Rep Row 2. Do not fasten off.

Border

Ch 1, sc evenly around outside edge of blanket, working 3 sc at each corner, join with sl st in top of beginning ch.

Picot Round*Ch 2, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sk 1 sc, sl st in next 2 sc, rep from * sk 1 sc more or less to end evenly. Fasten off.

Finishing: Weave in ends.
