

## Double Crochet Hat and Scarf Set

### Materials:

Knitted worsted weight yarn (#4). Approx. 95 yards for a woman's hat. 475 yards for a scarf measuring 9" wide X 60" long.

Hook: Size I crochet hook (or select hook size based on yarn type). Rather than trying to adjust the pattern to. Tapestry needle to weave in ends

### Note:

The size of this pattern can be altered very easily by using a yarn other than #4 Worsted and using the hook size recommended on the ball band (usually H or I hook for children; J or K hook for adults). The amount of yarn called for will change depending on the size of the set being made. The sample was created using worsted (#4) and a J hook for a woman's size and the yardage given is relevant to that yarn and size.

### Abbreviations:

ch chain  
dc double crochet  
rep repeat  
rnd(s) round(s)  
sc single crochet  
sl st slip stitch  
st(s) stitch(es)

### Patterns:

#### Hat

Beginning at top, ch 4, sl st in first ch to form ring.

Round 1: Ch 3, work 11 more dc in ring. Join with a sl st to top of ch 3. (12 dc) The beginning chain counts as your first st in each row. Do NOT turn at the end of the row.

Rather, continue to work in the round.

Round 2: Ch 3, dc in same st, 2 dc in each dc around. Join. (24 dc)

Round 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in next st, (dc in next st, 2 dc in next) around. Join. (36 dc)

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in next st, 2 dc in next, (dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next) around. Join. (48 dc)

Round 5: Ch 3, (dc in each dc around). Join.

Rounds 6 – 12: Ch 3, (dc in each dc around). Join.

Round 13 - 15: ch 1, sc in each st around. Join.

Round 16: ch 3, dc in each st around. Join and end off.

Fold last 5 rows to right side for cuff.



## Scarf

Ch 28 and turn

Row 1: Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook. dc in every chain across to end of row, ch 1, turn

Row 2-3: sc in every dc across, ch 1, turn

Row 4: sc in every sc across, ch 3, turn

Row 5: dc across row, ch 3, turn

Repeat row 5 until scarf is about 1" shorter than you want it to be and on last row, ch 1 rather than 3 at the end of the row

Next 2 rows: sc across

Next row: sc across, ch 3, turn

Final row: dc across and end

Weave in ends

Fringe if desired. Yarn for fringe is NOT included in **Materials** above.
