

Easy 2-Color Hat and Scarf Set

Size:

One Size

Scarf About 8 1/2 x 72 in. (21.5 x 183 cm)

Hat Finished Circumference 19 in. (48.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Gauge:

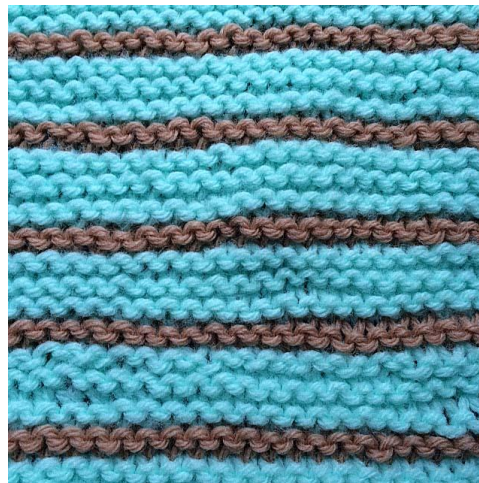
19 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row).

Abbreviations:

beg = begin(s)(ning)

rep = repeat(s)(ing)

st(s) = stitch(es)



Materials:

1. To make Scarf only, you will need 2 skeins of color A (400 yards total) and 1 skein of color B (200 yards).

2. To make Hat only, you will need ball of both A and B (200 yards of each color)

3. To make both hat and scarf you will need 3 skeins (600 yards) color A and 2 skeins (400 yards) color B.

Knitting Needles size #8. Straight can be used for the scarf but you will need either a circular #8, 24", for the hat (you will be knitting back and forth but will need a circular to accommodate the number of stitches)

Scarf:

With A, cast on 38 sts.

Rows 1-6: With A, knit.

Rows 7 and 8: With B, knit.

Rep Rows 1-8 until Scarf measures 72 in. from beg, ending with a Row 6.

Bind off.

Hat:

With A, cast on 88 on a 24" US #8 needle and DO NOT JOIN.

Rows 1-6: With A, knit.

Rows 7 and 8: With B, knit. Rep Rows 1-8 until Hat measures about 11 1/2 in. (29 cm) from beg, end with a Row 6.

Do not bind off. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Using a large-eyed blunt needle, thread tail through each st and remove from needle. Pull tightly together for top of Hat and use tail to sew side seam.

Finishing:

Weave in ends.
