

Easy Bulky Crochet Hat and Scarf Set

SIZE: One Size

Hat Finished Circumference about 19" but will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

Scarf: About 6 x 65 in. (15 x 165 cm)

MATERIALS:

150 yards bulky (#5) yarn for the hat
 300 yards bulky (#5) yarn for the scarf
 450 yards if making both
 Size K crochet hook
 Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE: 11 single crochet = about 4 in. (10 cm).

NOTES: Scarf is worked lengthwise.

Rib effect is created by working through back loops only.

HAT:

Chain 26.

Row 1: Single crochet in 2nd chain from hook and in each chain across - 25 stitches.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Working through back loops only, single crochet in each stitch across.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 19 in. (48.5 cm) from beginning. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through ends of rows along one long edge and pull to gather for top of Hat. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Seam sides of piece to make Hat. Weave in ends.

SCARF

Chain 181.

Row 1: Single crochet in 2nd chain from hook and in each chain across - 180 stitches. **Row 2:** Chain 1, turn. Working in back loops only, single crochet in each stitch across. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 6 in. (15 cm) from beginning.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.
