

Fast, Easy Double Crochet in the Hole Blanket

This blanket was inspired by the need for blankets and the desire to be able to crochet one without having to count or measure. This blanket is a great way to use up leftover yarn.

Since some people like having exact measurements, I am providing 2 sets of instructions – without and with counting and measuring.

No counting or measuring:

K hook for worsted weight (#4) / N or P for bulky yarns (#5 or 6)

Create a chain the desired width of your blanket

Row 1: DC in 4th ch from the hook, DC in each st across to the end, ch 3 and turn.

Row 2: DC in each DC hole (as shown in illustration below) across to the end and in the top of the chain 3 of the prior row, ch 3 and turn.

Row 3: DC in each DC hole (as shown in illustration below) across to the end, ch 3 and turn.

Repeat row 3 until desired length is reached.

Counting or measuring:

Worsted weight yarn (#4)

Finished size: 34" x 48"

K hook

Chain 84

Row 1: DC in 4th ch from the hook, DC in each st across to the end, ch 3 and turn.

Row 2: DC in each DC hole (as shown in illustration below) across to the end and in the top of the chain 3 of the prior row, ch 3 and turn.

Row 3: DC in each DC hole (as shown in illustration below) across to the end, ch 3 and turn.

Repeat row 3 until desired length is reached.

DC in the hole between the 2 rows as illustrated below
