

Feather and Fan Hat and Scarf Set

Materials:

Approx. 600 yards of #4 Acrylic yarn
 US9 16in circular needle or double pointed needles if preferred (for knitting in the round)
 US9 straight needles
 Tapestry needle

Gauge:

18sts = 4in (10cm) in feather & fan pattern

Finished Size:

Hat: Approx. 22in in circumference
 Scarf: Approx 12in wide by 4ft long, or desired length

Abbreviations:

dpn double pointed needles
 k knit
 k2tog knit the next 2 sts together
 p purl
 rep repeat
 rem remaining
 rnd(s) round(s)
 sts stitches
 yo yarn over



Patterns:

Hat:

Cast on 90 sts on circular needle or dpns (whichever you prefer to work with). Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist.

Rnds 1, 3: purl.

Rnds 2, 4: knit.

Rnd 5: *k2tog 3 times, (k1, yo) 6 times, k2tog 3 times*; rep between *s around.

Rnd 6: knit.

Rnd 7: purl.

Rnd 8: *p2tog 3 times, (p1, yo) 6 times, p2tog 3 times*; rep between *s around.

Rnd 9: purl.

Rep Rnds 4-9 twice more.

Shape Crown:

If using circular needle, switch to dpns when you begin to feel awkward on the circular.

Rnd 1: knit.

Rnd 2: *k2tog 3 times, k1, (k1, yo) 4 times, k1, k2tog 3 times*; rep between *s around - 80 sts.

Rnd 3: knit.

Rnd 4: purl.

Rnd 5: *p2tog 3 times, (p1, yo) 4 times, p2tog 3 times*; rep between *s around - 70 sts.

Rnd 6: purl.

Rnd 7: knit.

Rnd 8: *k2tog 2 times, k2, (k1, yo) 2 times, k2, k2tog 2 times*; rep between *s around - 60 sts.

Rnd 9: knit.

Rnd 10: purl.

Rnd 11: *p2tog 2 times, p1, (p1, yo) 2 times, p1, p2tog 2 times*; rep between *s around - 50 sts.

Rnd 12: purl.

Rnd 13: knit.

Rnd 14: *k2tog 2 times, (k1, yo) 2 times, k2tog 2 times*; rep between *s around - 40 sts.

Rnd 15: knit.

Rnd 16: purl.

Rnd 17: p2tog around – 20 sts.

Rnd 18: purl.

Rnd 19: k2tog around – 10 sts.

Rnd 20: knit.

Rnd 21: k2tog around – 5 sts.

Cut tail and thread through remaining stitches. Pull tight and tie off. Weave in ends.

Scarf:

The scarf works up to be almost 12” wide as written so, if you want a narrower or wider scarf, add or subtract in multiples of 18 sts. The sample was worked on 38 sts and is 7.5” wide.

CO 56 on circular or straight needles, whichever is more comfortable for you to work on. You will be working back and forth for the scarf.

Rows 1-4: purl.

Row 5: sl1, *k2tog 3 times, (k1, yo) 6 times, k2tog 3 times*; rep between *s to last st, k1.

Rep Rows 3-5 to desired length, ending with Row 5.

Purl 4 rows.

Bind off and weave in ends.



Note:

If you prefer to make a **COWL** rather than a scarf, cast on CO 90 sts on circular needles and work the same as the hat but **DO NOT** decrease for the crown and rep rnds 4-9 4 more times. The pattern is below.



Cast on 90 sts on circular needle or dpns (whichever you prefer to work with). Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist.

Rnds 1, 3: purl.

Rnds 2, 4: knit.

Rnd 5: *k2tog 3 times, (k1, yo) 6 times, k2tog 3 times*; rep between *s around.

Rnd 6: knit.

Rnd 7: purl.

Rnd 8: *p2tog 3 times, (p1, yo) 6 times, p2tog 3 times*; rep between *s around.

Rnd 9: purl.

Rep Rnds 4-9 4 times more.
