

Heavier Weight Garter Weave Baby Blanket

Note:

2 strands of yarn are held together throughout which makes this blanket heavier than most baby blankets. It is an excellent choice for colder weather or for a blanket to lay a baby on for 'floor time' and is a very quick knit.

Materials:

Size 13 circular needle, 24" – 36" length
Roughly 800 yards #4 Worsted Weight yarn
Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Approx. Size:

32" X 32"

Gauge:

Approx. 2.5 stitches/inch

Abbreviations:

K knit
P Purl

Pattern:

Using yarn held double, cast on 77 stitches and K 9 rows and then begin stitch pattern as follows;

Stitch Pattern:

Row 1: K7, (P3, K9) 5 times, P3, K7
Row 2: K4, P3, (K3, P9) 5 times, K3, P3, K4
Row 3: Repeat row 1
Row 4: K
Row 5: K13, (P3, K9) 5 times, K4
Row 6: K4, (P9, K3) 5 times, P9, K4
Row 7: Repeat row 5
Row 8: K

Repeat rows 1 –8, 13 more times (14 repeats total)

K 8 rows
Bind Off
Weave in ends
