

## Light and Lacy Rectangular Shawl

### Materials:

1020 (e.g. Red Heart Pound of Love) to 1200 yards of Worsted Weight (#4) acrylic yarn  
 US #11 knitting needles  
 Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

### Abbreviations

co = cast on  
 k = knit  
 k2tog = knit 2 together  
 rep = repeat  
 yo = yarn over

### Completed Size:

Shawl will be about 30" wide by 60" (if using Red Heart Pound of Love, 1020 yards up to 70" if using 1200 yards of yarn)

### PATTERN:

Co 90 stitches – do not use the long tail cast on as this will be too tight for the completed fabric

Row 1: K1, \*yo, k2tog; rep from \* ending with k1.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: K2, \*yo, k2tog; rep from \* to end.

Row 4: Purl.

Repeat rows 1-4 until piece measures as long as you want it to be, leaving 11-12 feet of yarn to bind off. End after a row 2 or 4.

Lightly block if necessary. Using tapestry needle, weave in ends.
