

## Mistake Stitch Hat and Scarf Set in Two Sizes (Child and Adult)

### Materials:

325(400) yards Bulky weight yarn (#5)  
 US size 11 needles – 16” circular and double pointed for the hat,  
 straight for the scarf  
 Stitch marker  
 Tapestry needle to weave in ends

### Abbreviations:

k knit  
 p purl  
 k2tog knit 2 together  
 dec decrease  
 rnd round  
 st(s) stitch(es)

### Finished Measurements:

**Hat:** Approximate  
 circumference 20” (21.5”)  
**Scarf:** Approximately 6”  
 (8”) wide by 48” long



### Hat

Mistake Stitch Pattern (multiple of 4 sts) for working in the round.

Rnd 1: \*k2, p2; rep from \*

Rnd 2: k1, \*p2, k2; rep from \*, end p2, k1.

Rep these 2 rnds for pattern st.

With circular needle, cast on 60, (64) sts (long tail cast on is best) and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist. Place marker to note beginning of round.

Work in mistake stitch for 6”, (7), ending after a Rnd 2

### Dec Rnds

Switching to double pointed needles,

Rnd 1: \*K2, k2tog; rep from \* around. 45, (48) sts.

Rnd 2: \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* around. 30, (32) sts.

Rnd 3: \*K2tog; rep from \* around. 15, (16) sts.

Rnd 4: K1, (0), \*k2tog; rep from \* around. 8, (8) sts.

Cut yarn and draw through purl wise through these 8 sts.

Cinch tight and weave in all ends.



### Scarf

Mistake Stitch Pattern for working flat (multiple of 4 +3)

Row 1: K2, p2, repeat to last 3 stitches, k2, p1.

Cast on 31 (39) stitches.

Work Row 1 until piece is 48” long or as long as you want it.

Bind off in stitch pattern. Weave in ends.

Add fringe if desired but be aware that materials list does not include sufficient yarn for a fringe so you will have to procure additional yarn.
