

Nifty Leftovers Loopy Scarf

Sample made with **worsted weight yarn**, knitted on **size 11** needles

Cast on 9 stitches. Work in stockinette stitch (knit 1 row, purl 1 row) approximately 14 inches. Leave about a 14 or 15 inch bind off tail. This is used for stitching together narrow ends.

Take first loop and join into a circle using whip stitch. Take second loop and bring it through the first completed loop and then whip stitch this loop to form a circle. Take third loop, bring through second loop, form a circle and whip stitch it together. Repeat for all remaining loops.



Sample loops are each approximately 14 inches long and about 2.5 inches wide. Long edges will curl under and seaming long edges is not necessary. Cast on tail is just hidden in the side curl. Loop ends are whip stitched together.

This is a great group project. Each person could make several strips, all stitched together for a very quick use of leftovers and very interesting scarf for donating.
