

Quick Knit Seed Stitch Hat and Scarf Set

Materials:

~85 yards of super bulky (#6) yarn – must be a soft to the touch yarn – for the hat

~ 174 yards of a soft super bulky (#6) yarn for the scarf

(Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick and Quick was used for the sample – 1 skein for hat, 2 for scarf)

US 13 16" circular needle & US 13 dpns (double pointed needles) for the hat

US 15 straight needles for the scarf

Stitch marker

Abbreviations:

k knit

p purl

p3tog purl next 3 stitches together

rep repeat

rnd round

st(s) stitch(es)

Patterns:

Hat:

Cast on 44 sts and join to work in the round being careful not to twist work. Place marker to note beginning of round

Rnd 1 through 8: k 2, p2

Rnd 9: k2, p2, to last st. On last st, p in front and k in back of st (45 sts on needle)

Then begin pattern as follows:

Rnd 1: P1, K1

Rnd 2: K1, P1

Repeat last two rounds until hat measures 7.5" inches from cast on edge, ending after a rnd 1.

Decrease for crown: (switch to dpns when necessary)

Rnd 1: p3tog, k1. Repeat all the way around and purl the last stitch. (23 sts)

Rnd 2: k1, p1 around

Rnd 3: p3tog, k1. Repeat all the way around to last 3 sts. P3tog (11 sts)

Rnd 4: k1, p1 around

Break yarn and thread purl-wise through stitches on your needle, pull tight to close the hat up. Weave in ends.

Scarf:



Scarf as knit is slightly over 7" wide. For a wider scarf, add sts in multiples of 2 (every additional 2 sts will increase width of scarf by approximately 3/4")

Using US #15 needles, cast on 17 sts.

Row 1: *p1, k1 rep from * to last st. p1

Repeat Row 1 until scarf is 60" long or until you almost run out of yarn. Cast off knit-wise and weave in ends.
