

Reversible Hat and Scarf Set (Hat)

Hat is knit using size 6 circular for the rib and 8 circular for the body with a Worsted yarn (gauge of 18sts and 24rows = 4" US #4 yarn). It will fit an average sized woman

The hat should be knit to the specifications below but changing the yarn and using needles matched to the yarn will change the size of the hat.

Materials: Worsted Yarn – see note above
 # 6 and #8 circular needle 16"long. Or set of size US # 6 and 8 DP (double pointed) needles for hat
 US #7 and #8 straight needles for scarf – see note above
 Markers

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Method: Using # 6 needle, cast on 96 stitches, join, place marker, 2 X 1 rib for 8 rows

Change to #8 circular needle and pattern as follows:

Round 1 Knit
 Round 2 Knit
 Round 3 K1, P2 (knit1, purl 2) around
 Round 4 K1, P2 around

Work these four rounds until hat is 4" for a child, 5" for an adult from beginning, end with round 4

Decrease as follows: - change to #8 DP needles when necessary for you

Round 1 (K2tog, K10) around (88 sts)
 Round 2 K
 Round 3 (K2tog, K1, P2, K1, P2, K1, P2) around (80 sts)
 Round 4 (K2, P2, K1, P2, K1, P2,) around
 Round 5 (K2 tog, K8) around (72 sts)
 Round 6 K
 Round 7 (K2tog, P1, K1, P2, K1, P2) (64sts)
 Round 8 (K1, P1, K1, P2, K1, P2) around
 Round 9 (K2tog, K6) around (56 sts)
 Round 10 K
 Round 11 (K2tog, P2, K1, P2) around (48 sts)
 Round 12 (K1, P2) around
 Round 13 (K2tog, K4) around (40 sts)
 Round 14 K
 Round 15 (K2tog, K1, P2) around (32 sts)
 Round 16 (K2, P2) around
 Round 17 (K2tog, K2) around (24sts)
 Round 18 K
 Round 19 (K2tog, P1) around (16 sts)
 Round 20 (K1, P1) around



Cut a 10" tail and, using a tapestry needle, slip stitches purl-wise off needles, Pull together tightly and secure. Weave in ends carefully so they are not visible.

Reversible Hat and Scarf Set (Scarf)

Worsted Weight Yarn (#4)

US #7 and #8 straight needles

K = knit

P = purl

Cast on multiple of 3 stitches (36 sts will give a scarf of 6 ½” wide as the ‘ribbing’ effect of the pattern cause the work to be slightly more narrow than the math would seem to suggest. For a narrower or wider scarf, decrease or increase the stitches in multiples of 3

Cast on 36 stitches using the long tail cast on if you know that method. If not, just be sure your cast on is not loose. You might want to use the #7 needle to cast on if you do not know the long tail method.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K1, P2 across row

Row 4: K2, P1 across row

Repeat these 4 rows until scarf is as long as you want, ending after row 2 if you have used the long tail method to cast on. Then, using the US #7 needles, cast off purl-wise (on the right side of the work).

If you did another form of cast on, end after row 1 and cast off knit-wise on the wrong side of the work, using the #7 needles.

Weave in ends.
