

## Ripple Wheelchair Blanket

**Approximate Size:** 27" X 38"

**Yarn:** #4 Worsted Weight (can be made from one color or any combination of colors).

**Sample:** Colors: A = Red, B = White, C = Blue  
6 rows of color A, 2 rows of B, 6 rows of color C. Begin and end with 6 rows of color A or C

**Hook:** K

**Pattern Multiple:** 16 plus 2

### Abbreviations:

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

yo - yarn over

3 st dec - 3 stitch decrease (dc3tog) \*yo, insert hook through next stitch, yo and pull loop through stitch, yo over and pull through first 2 loops on hook; Repeat from \* twice. Yo and pull through remaining 4 loops on hook.

2 st dec - 2 stitch decrease (dc2tog)- \*yo, insert hook through next stitch, yo and pull loop through stitch yo and pull through first 2 loops on hook; Repeat from \* once. yo and pull through remaining 3 loops on hook

**Changing colors:** At end of row, when working the 2 st dec, drop the current color of yarn when you have the last 3 loops left on your hook to finish the stitch. Yarn over with new color yarn and pull through 3 loops on hook. Chain 2 and turn.

### To begin:

Chain 82.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook; dc in next 6 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 6 ch; \*work 3 st dec in next 3 ch, dc in next 6 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 6 ch; repeat from \* across. End by working 2 st dec in last 2 ch. ch 2 and turn.

Row 2: Skip first stitch; dc in next 7 ch, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc; \*work 3 st dec in next 3 stitches, dc in next 6 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc; Repeat from \* across. End by working 2 st dec in last dc. Ch 2 and turn.

Repeat row 2 until blanket measures approximately 38 inches.

Weave in all ends securely.
