

Sallie's Hat

Materials:

Size 10 needles

Scrap cotton yarn in worsted (#4) weight. Varying amounts and colors

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Pattern:

Cast on 30 stitches and knit or purl or combination of both until strip measures 20 inches stretching to 22 inches, changing yarn colors as you use your different amounts. No rules regarding stitch combinations except that you should always tie on your new yarn at the same edge. Cast off.

Join cast on edge to cast off edge.

Upper edge:

Pick up 66 stitches around the tie-on edge and knit eight rows.

Knit two together next row and each row until 8 or 10 stitches remain. Cut yarn leaving a long tail to attach crown to hat after folding over crown.

Lower edge:

Pick up 72 stitches and knit one row.

Row 2: Bind off by knit one, yarn over, knit one, pass yarn over over last stitch knitted then pass next stitch over first stitch on needle. Yarn over, knit one and repeat around.

Work in ends. Fold crown over about 3 inches down and tack in place.
