

Seed Stitch Scarf with Pockets

Materials:

US straight knitting needles, sizes #8 and 9
 250 yards worsted weight (#4) yarn
 Tapestry Needle

Size:

~5.5 "wide by 62" long (after ends are folded up and sewn)

Abbreviations:

k knit
 p purl
 rep repeat
 st(s) stitch(es)

Pattern:

Using #8 needle, cast on 23 sts, leaving a tail of about 16" long

Change to #9 needle and work seed stitch pattern as follows

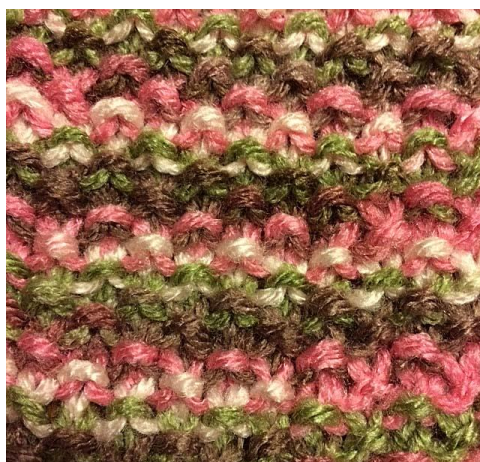
Row 1: *k1, p1, Rep from * to last st, k1

Repeat Row 1 until your piece is ~ 74" long.

Cast off with smaller (#8) needle and cut yarn leaving a tail of about 16"

Turn up 6" length on each end of the scarf and, using tapestry needle and tails of yarn, sew to the main portion of the scarf neatly to form pockets. If necessary, turn pockets so stitching is on the inside of the pockets.

Weave in any ends
