

Slouchy Beanie

(Matches Jeanette's Knitted Leftovers Scarf found in the Scarves Section)

Materials:

US Size 7 Needles, 4 double pointed and 1 16" circular
2.5 oz. (approx. 120 yards) worsted weight (#4) acrylic yarn
10 stitch markers, 1 unique color and 9 others of another color

Abbreviations:

k knit
k2tog knit 2 together
m1 make 1 stitch by inserting the left needle from front to back into the horizontal bar between the two stitches, placing that bar on the needle and knitting through the back loop.
p purl
p2tog purl 2 together
rep repeat
rnd round
st(s) stitch(es)



Finished Size:

The sample hat was made with #7 needles and #4 yarn and fits an average to large woman's head. For a size small hat, use size 6 needles. Pattern can also be used for an even smaller or larger head by using different weight yarn and a needle one size smaller than called for on the ball band.

Pattern:

This hat was designed using the stitch pattern from Jeanette's Knitted Leftover Scarf and can be made from one variegated yarn or by using a different leftover yarn for each section.

Cast on 92 stitches, join to work in the round being careful not to twist and placing the unique colored marker to note beginning of round

Rnds 1 – 9: k2, p2 rib around

Rnd 10: *(k 11, m1, k 12, m) rep from * around. 8 sts increased (100 sts total)

Then begin body of hat in sections as follows (hat is knit in the round so the sections are worked in a different fashion from flat knitting):

Rnds 1 – 5: Garter Stitch

Rnd 1: p

Rnd 2: k

Rnd 3: p

Rnd 4: k

Rnd 5: p



Rnds 6 -10 Stockinette Stitch

Rnd 6: k

Rnd 7: k

Rnd 8: k

Rnd 9: k

Rnd 10: k

Rnds 11 – 15: Seed Stitch

Rnd 11: *(k1, p1) rep from * around

Rnd 12: *(p1, k1) rep from * around

Rnd 13: *(k1, p1) rep from * around

Rnd 14: *(p1, k1) rep from * around

Rnd 15: *(k1, p1) rep from * around

Rnds 16 – 20: Stockinette Stitch

Rnd 16: k

Rnd 17: k

Rnd 18: k

Rnd 19: k

Rnd 20: k

Rnds 21 – 25: Purl Stitch

Rnd 21: p

Rnd 22: p

Rnd 23: p

Rnd 24: p

Rnd 25: p

Rnds 26 – 30: Stockinette Stitch

Rnd 26: k

Rnd 27: k

Rnd 28: k

Rnd 29: k

Rnd 30: *(k 10, place marker) rep from * around

Decrease for crown: (this follows the same section sequence as given above). Move to double pointed needles when necessary.

Rnd 1: *(p8, p2tog) rep from * around (90 sts)

Rnd 2: k

Rnd 3: *(p7, p2tog) rep from * around (80 sts) noting that the stitches tog'd will be the 2 immediately before the markers

Rnd 4: k

Rnd 5: *(p6, p2tog) rep from * around (70 sts)

Rnd 6: k



Rnd 7: *(k5, k2tog) rep from * around (60 sts)

Rnd 8: k

Rnd 9: *(k4, k2tog) rep from * around (50 sts)

Rnd 10: k

Rnd 11: *(k1, p1, k1, p2tog) rep from * around (40 sts)

Rnd 12: *(p1, k1, p1, k1) rep from * around

Rnd 13: *(k1, p1, k2tog) rep from * around (30 sts)

Rnd 14: *(p1, k2tog, remove marker) rep from * around (20 sts)

Rnd 15: k2tog, p2tog around (10 sts)

Using tapestry needle, remove these 10 stitches purl wise from the needles, cinch up tightly and weave in all ends. Do not block.
