

Small Bag for Walker or the Side of a Wheelchair

Patterns:

Bag: 11" x 22" (cut one)

Pocket: 7" x 8" (contrasting fabric – cut one)

Straps: 2" x 12" – cut four

Instructions:

1. Finish top edge of pocket and iron other three edges under.
2. Optional: Applique a small heart onto the pocket.
3. Stitch pocket to front of one side of the main bag. (fold main bag to place pocket appropriately)
4. Finish straps by folding inwardly and top stitching. Finished straps will be about ½ inch wide.
5. On back side of fabric, pin the straps approximately 1 inch down from the top and spaced so that two will be on the front and two on the back of the finished bag, across from each other when the bag is finished.
6. Fold the top edge of the bag twice toward the wrong side of the fabric so that the new top hem comes across the top of the pinned straps. Stitch the hem being sure to catch the top of the straps.
7. Turn the straps up toward the top of the bag and stitch again close to the top edge of the bag, attaching the straps to the inside of the hem.
8. Fold bag in half and finish the side and bottom seams of the bag.
