Stay Put Scarf

Materials:

2 oz worsted weight (#4) acrylic yarn (Red Heart was used for the sample)

Size G crochet hook

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Finished Size:

5.5" wide X 34" long

Abbreviations:

ch chain

dc double crochetsc single crochet



Pattern:

Row 1: ch 18, dc in second ch from hook and in next 15 chains, ch 2, turn (16dc)

Rows 2-6: dc in each dc, ch 2, turn (16 dc)

Row 7: dc in 8 dc, ch 2 turn

Rows 8–13: Repeat row 7, cut yarn leaving a 2" tail

Row 8a: Attach yarn at end of row 6 on the other side, ch 2, turn Rows 9a-13a: ch 2 dc in the same space as ch 2, dc in next 7 dc, ch 2, turn

Row 14: dc across 1st section (8dc), continue to dc across next 8dc, ch 2, turn

Rows 15-55 dc across 16dc, ch 2, turn

Row 56: *skip 2dc, 5dc in next dc, skip 2dc and sc in next dc. Repeat from * twice more ending with skip 1dc, sc in last dc. Finish off

Attach yarn to other end of scarf and repeat row 56

Border:

Attach yarn and sc evenly all around, working 2 sc in each chain 2 or dc along the sides. SC in stitches at each end. Finish off and weave in ends.
