

Super Simple Keyhole Scarf

Materials:

Approximately 120 yards worsted weight (#4) yarn
 US Size 9 needles
 Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Size:

Approximately 6.5" X 29.5"

Abbreviations:

k – knit
 p – purl
 rs – right side
 sts – stitches
 ws – wrong side



Pattern:

co 26 sts using long tail cast-on (if you do not know this technique, use whatever technique you know but pay attention to the number of rows you need to knit at the end before cast off)
 k 10 rows

Row 11 (rs row): k

Row 12 (ws row) k5, p16, k5

Repeat rows 11 and 12 until scarf is approximately 26" long, ending after a row 12 (ws row)

Next row: k9, cast off 8 sts, k9 (because of the cast off, there will already be one of these 9 sts on the right hand needle)

Next row: k5, p4, turn work and cast on 8 sts, turn work and p4, k5

Work rows 11 and 12 again for approximately 2.5" ending after a row 1

If your cast on was long tail, you will knit 10 rows and cast off on the wrong side.

If you used any other cast on, you will knit 9 rows and cast off on the right side.

Weave in ends.

Note: the sample is not true to pattern size in terms of length but it is the same width.
