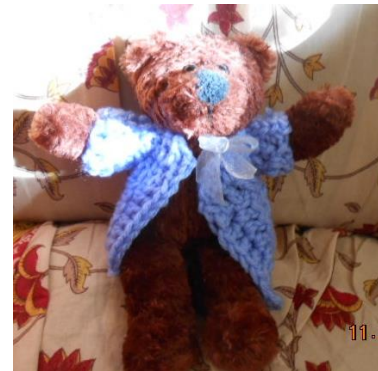


all the way! Sew the seam from the wrist (or end of the sleeve) to the neck mark. Fasten off and secure the yarn and sew the other sleeve. You could slip stitch or single crochet the seams if you like, or whipstitch them from the inside, or as a decorative seam on the outside.

And there you are! Your sweater is done!

Variations -

- work the last row or 2 in a contrasting color, and work the sleeve/shoulder seam in that color as well
- work each section in a different color
- skip the sleeves entirely and make it an open vest
- work a ruffle instead of a sleeve, or work a short sleeve and add a ruffle. If you've wanted to try a fancy decorative bind off, give that a try for the end of the sleeve
- make the body a little bit longer to make it looser, then when finished, sew up the front seam as well to make a pullover sweater. Try it on the bear as you sew to see if you need to leave it open a little.
- add a button loop and a button, if the bear is not going to a small child
- add a ribbon tie
- what can you think of?



## Amigurumi Turtle

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size 2 in. (5 cm) tall

### MATERIALS

- Lion Brand Wool Ease: Lemongrass 1 Ball (A)
- Lion Brand Wool -Ease® Yarn Avocado 1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6, Lion Brand Stitch Markers, Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials: 2 plastic safety eyes, 6 mm diameter Fiberfill stuffing

### Stitch explanation:

**sc2tog (sc decrease)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

### ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(s)(ning)    ch(s) = chain(s)  
 rep = repeat(s)(ing)    rnd(s) = round(s)  
 sc = single crochet    st(s) = stitch(es)

### NOTES:

Work in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.

### UPPER SHELL

With A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch; place a marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each sc around - 12 sc.

**Rnd 3:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from \* around - 18 sc. **Rnd 4:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from \* around - 24 sc. **Rnd 5:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from \* around - 30 sc. **Rnd 6:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from \* around - 36 sc. **Rnd 7:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc; rep from \* around - 42 sc. **Rnd 8:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc; rep from \* around - 48 sc. **Rnds 9-14:** Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off.

### BOTTOM SHELL

With B, ch 2.

**Rnds 1-8:** Work Rnds 1-8 of Top Shell - 48 sc. Fasten off.
