

Window Panes Baby Blanket(s)

Materials:

Size US #9 knitting needles: 29" circular (used to accommodate the large number of stitches – you will not be knitting in the round)

Approximately 850 yards of worsted weight (#4) acrylic yarn

Tapestry Needle

Gauge:

18 sts = 4", 24 rows = 4" using size 9 needles and #4 yarn over stockinette (k rs row, p ws row)

Size:

Approx. 31" X 31"

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

K = Knit

P = Purl

Rep = repeat

RS = right side

Sts = stitches

WS = wrong side

Pattern #1 – Subtle Window Panes:

Using 29" size 9 needles, CO 133 sts

Knit 5 rows than begin pattern stitch as follows:

Row 1: WS of work: Knit (knitting on WS creates a ridge on RS)

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: K3, *P3; K1 rep from * to last 6 sts, P3, K3

Row 4: Knit.

Rep these 4 rows until blanket is 1/2" less than you want it to be, ending after Row 1 of pattern stitch rows.

Knit 5 rows and cast off

Finishing

Weave in ends.

Pattern #2 – Not so Subtle Window Panes:

Using 29” size 9 needles, CO 133 sts

Knit 5 rows than begin pattern stitch as follows:

Row 1: WS of work: Knit (knitting on WS creates a ridge on RS)

Row 2: K3, *K3, P1 rep from * to last 6 sts, K6

Row 3: K3, *P3; K1 rep from * to last 6 sts, P3, K3

Row 4: K3, *K3, P1 rep from * to last 6 sts, K6

Rep these 4 rows until blanket is ½ “ less than you want it to be, ending after Row 1 of pattern stitch rows.

Knit 5 rows and cast off

Finishing

Weave in ends.
