

## **Double Knitting**

### **(Small Pouch)**

***Cast on an even number of stitches, twice the number of stitches you wish for width of pouch. Use a needle one size smaller than the yarn calls for.***

***First stitch is always knitted; last stitch is always slipped with yarn in front.***

***Row 1: knit 1 stitch, bring yarn to front of work, slip second stitch as to purl, move working yarn to back of stitch. Continue this pattern to end of row. Last stitch will always be yarn in front, slip 1 as to purl.***

***Turn work and repeat this first row until piece measures desired length.***

***Bind Off: Divide the stitches onto two double pointed needles. Slip the knit stitches onto one and the slipped purl stitches onto the second. This will separate the two sides creating a little sac. You can now bind off all the stitches.***

***You might like to create an I-cord strap for you bag.***
