

Hand warmers

Name of Yarn: Red Heart Supersaver, (9/5.5 needle size)

4 size 8 D. P. Needles

Scissors

Cast on 36 Stitches and divide evenly onto 3 needles
– 12 sts per needle

Join into a round being careful not to twist and place a
marker where you join to mark the beginning of the
row



K2, P2, K2, P2 for 6 1/2" (~ 40 rounds), slipping marker each time you come to it

Make thumb opening. When you get to the marker on this row, remove it and set it aside for
later. Turn your work and work in established pattern for 10 rows, going back and forth, turning
at the end of each row, as for straight knitting

Rejoin the two sides on the next row by not turning your work but, rather, slipping the marker
onto the needle and proceeding to work in the round again in established pattern for 1 3/4" (~12
rounds)

Cast off in rib

Weave in ends
