Thank you for coming to this class offering today. If you have never used the i-cord bind off, this is the class for you.

Why use an i-cord bind off?

I-Cord Bind-Off – Very stretchy and adds a tubular edging to your fabric. Great for blankets, especially if you used an i-cord cast-on. It's a time-consuming bind-off, but offers as much stretch as the fabric you're binding off as well as a very neat edge.

I used the i-cord bind off for the first time following a FREE Ravelry download by Stephen West called The Boneyard Shawl.
