## From the Pillowcase

These instructions will make one standard pillowcase. Note that all widths of fabric (WOF) may not be the same. That's OK, just center the fabrics.

All fabric cuts are WOF.

## Fabric:

Main body.....26" strip of your favorite fabric Accent strip...2 1/2" strip of coordinating fabric Cuff..........10" strip of fabric

## **Directions:**

Fold the Accent strip in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press. Pin the raw edge of the Accent strip to the right side of the raw edge of the pillowcase body.

Turn the whole unit over.

Pin the right side of the Cuff to the wrong side of the body of the pillowcase, matching raw edges.

The Cuff will be on one side and the Accent piece will be on the other side. The body will be in the middle. Turn the entire unit over.

Roll up the body of the pillowcase, starting at the bottom edge.
Bring the Cuff around the rolled up Main body matching raw edges together.
Pin the Cuff and Accent strip to the body of the pillowcase.
You now have a tube.

Sew a 1/4" seam along the pinned edge. Remove any pins.
Pull out the pillowcase through the tube.
Press the Cuff so it lays flat.
Trim the sides edges even.

Fold the pillowcase in half, wrong sides together, being careful to match the Cuff, Accent strip, and edges of the pillowcase. Pin.

Stitch a 1/4" seam along the along the side and bottom edges. Turn the pillow right sides together and press. Sew a !/2" seam along the bottom and side edges. Turn right sides out and press You now have a pillowcase!
